Show & Tell: **Kurt Hertzog** – square turnings, vases, bowls, **Marwin Feldman** – completed segmented turnings from last meeting, **Jim Vasi** – maple bowls, spalted maple bowl, **Bob Ball** – wine stoppers from colored wood & Christmas ornaments, **Steve Imerese** – artisan vessel, **Bill Allan** – purple heart & puduke bowl, **Jim Hilburger** – specialty tools, **Frank Stanko** – specialty tail centers, extremely thin stem challis *Thank you all, for sharing!!!!*

Demo: **Bob Ball** showed how he cuts the stem of a glass wine glass. Then using the lathe, he makes a wood base and stem of different kinds of woods, that are complimentary. Using specially ground paddle bits, he drills holes for the glass stem and flared base of the wine glass. Then with a touch of glue, you have a wood base, wood stem, and glass vessel wine glass. Mark St. Leger Demo/Workshop - The Turners 2 will be hosting Mark St. Leger for an all day demonstration and two days of hands-on workshops. The demonstration will be Saturday May 22 at the Charles Lindbergh Elementary School, 184 Irving Terrace, Kenmore N.Y. During the course of the day, Mark will be demonstrating the turning of an executive spin top (spins for 3 minutes or more), a rocker bowl turned on a bias, an off center pod box, and a lidded vessel with hand chased threads. There are also great raffle prizes including a grinder, a cordless drill, wood, woodturning books, and more being arranged.
